Arrows	Move
CTRL + Arrows	Go to End of Continuous Range
SHIFT + Arrows	Select A Cell Range

CTRL + SHIFT + Arrows	Highlight A Continuous Range
ALT + Tab	Switch Programs
CTRL + Pg Up/Down	Switch Worksheets
Shift + Enter	Move Up
Enter	Move below
Home	Move to Beginning of Line
ESC	Cancel
Alt + Enter (when in a cell)	Add a Line
CTRL + Home	Go to Cell A1

## ENTERING DATA

Shortcut-keys	Description
---------------	-------------

ALT+ENTER	Start a new line in the same cell
CTRL + DELETE	Delete text to the end of the line
SHIFT + F2	Edit a cell comment
CTRL+ENTER	Fill the selected cell range with entry
SHIFT +ENTER	Finish entry and move up in a selection
TAB	Finish entry and move right in selection
SHIFT +TAB	Finish entry and move left in selection

## SELECTING CELLS

Shortcut-keys	Description
CTRL+SHIFT + *	Select current region around active cell
SHIFT+ ARROW	Extend selection by one cell
CTRL +SHIFT+ ARROW	Extend selection to last nonblank cell
SHIFT+HOME	Extend selection to start of row
CTRL+SHIFT+HOME	Extend selection to top left
CTRL+SHIFT+END	Extend selection to last cell used
CTRL+SPACEBAR	Select the entire column
SHIFT + SPACEBAR	Select the entire row
SHIFT +BACKSPACE	Only select active cell
SHIFT+ PAGE DOWN	Extend selection down one screen

SHIFT+ PAGE UP	Extend selection up one screen
END	Turn End mode on or off
END or SHIFT+ARROW KEY	Extend selection to the last nonblank cell

ALT + `	Display the STYLE
CTRL + 1	FORMAT CELLS
CTRL + SHIFT + ~	General number format
CTRL + SHIFT + !	Comma and 2 decimals
CTRL + SHIFT + #	1-Jan-00 format
CTRL + SHIFT + \$	Dollar format
CTRL + SHIFT + %	Percentage format
CTRL + SHIFT + &	Outline border
CTRL + SHIFT + _	Remove outline border
CTRL + SHIFT + @	1/1/1900 0:00 AM format
CTRL + SHIFT + ^	.# # E + 02 format
CTRL + SHIFT + ENTER	Enter array formula
CTRL + SHIFT + *	Selects current region

ALT + E + S + T	Copy Format
ALT + H + 0	Increase Decimal
ALT + H + 9	Decrease Decimal
CTRL + SHIFT + 7	Boxing
ALT + O + C + A	Fit Column Width
ALT + H + O + R	Change Tab Name
ALT + W + F	(Un)Split Panes
ALT + W + S	(Un)freeze windows
SHIFT + CTRL + #	Date Format

## Columns & Rows Shortcuts

Shortcut keys	Description
CTRL + 9	Hide Row
SHIFT + CTRL + 9	Unhide Row
CTRL + 0	Hide Column
SHIFT + CTRL + 0	Unhide Column
SHIFT + Spacebar	Highlight Row

CTRL + Spacebar	Highlight Column
SHIFT + CTRL + Plus sign	Insert Blank Cells
CTRL + Minus Sign	Delete Selected Cells
SHIFT + ALT + Left Arrow	Group Rows/Columns
SHIFT + ALT + Right Arrow	Ungroup Rows/Columns

## SPECIAL KEYS

Shortcut keys	Description
CTRL + [	Select cells referred to by formula
CTRL+ SHIFT+ {	Select all cells that are directly or indirectly referred to by formulas
cell CTRL + ]	Select only cells with formulas that refer directly to the active
CTRL + SHIFT+ }	Select only cells with formulas that refer directly or indirectly to the active cell
ATL+PAGE DOWN/UP	One screen right or left
